Legislative, APRN/ BRN updates:

- -December 30, 2022: the OAL formally approved the final AB 890 regulation adopted by the BRN -AB 890 went into effect on January 1, 2023
- -The BRN is developing a new 103 NP BreEZe application scheduled for release in January 2023 and will send out a notice to all NPs with information on eligibility and instructions on how to apply.

Reminder: Voting process as a board per CANP Bylaws:

Section 8. Quorum. At least fifty percent (50%) of the credentialed delegates at the House of Delegates shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any official meeting.

Section 9. Board Action. (a) Every act or decision done or made by a majority of the Board of Directors present at a meeting duly held at which a quorum is present is the act of the Board of Directors. If a director abstains from participating in an item of business because of a declared conflict of interest, that member shall be treated as not present for purposes of determining the outcome of the vote, but shall be counted for purposes of establishing that a quorum was present.
