#### **AB 890**

AB 890 by Assemblymember Jim Wood (D-Santa Rosa), which would allow NPs to work without physician supervision, passed out of the California Legislature on August 31 with a two-thirds, bipartisan vote in the Senate and a concurrent 53-1 vote in the Assembly.



The bill now is on Governor Gavin Newsom's desk, and he has until September 30 to either sign or veto the bill.

Please encourage your chapter members to continue to use their voice to support AB 890. They can tag on social media or write to their Senator to show support for AB 890 and urge a YES vote when the bill comes up for a vote. Below are sample social media messages for Governor Newsom.

#### **Taxes**

It is each chapter's responsibility to apply for and maintain federal and state tax-exempt status. CANP offers the following resources to assist chapters with filing their taxes:

- <u>CANP Chapter Federal & State Filing Exemption Instruction Manual</u> Provides direction in how to verify your chapter's status and other helpful resources
- Ask a Tax Question Allows chapter leaders to ask questions about tax filings and other issues related to financial aspects of running a local chapter
- Twice yearly leadership calls focused on tax filings (January and August)

As a reminder: If your chapter tax year is calendar year (ending December 31) and your chapter is a corporation, please file your federal and California tax returns by March 15. If your chapter is tax exempt, the tax filing date is May 15. If your chapter is on a fiscal year (ending June 30), please file your federal and California tax returns by September 15. If you are tax exempt, the deadline November 15. Please consult your chapter tax advisor for more detailed information.

#### **Political Action Committee**

The Political Action Committee (PAC) is a critical part of the Association's advocacy efforts, and we encourage chapters to continue to raise funds. The PAC funds convey our strength in numbers and a commitment to engage in the legislative process. The current balance in the PAC account is \$42,694.

**Note:** All PAC donations must be submitted via personal check or credit card. Donations via cash or cashier's check are <u>not</u> permitted. All donations must be submitted to CANP no later than 30 days post receipt of the donation.
