## ASSOCIATION NEWS

### *AB 890 Bill Implementation*

CANP and our [Close the Provider Gap](#) coalition partners continue to work with the California Board of Registered Nursing (BRN) on the implementation of AB 890. At the BRN's Nurse Practitioner Advisory Committee (NPAC) Interested Parties Meeting on Oct. 26, BRN staff presented [draft AB 890 regulations](#) to the committee and the public. (Note: the NPAC reports to the BRN Nursing Practice Committee, which then makes formal recommendations to the full Board. The BRN has sole authority for approval of any regulations to be put into place).

The draft AB 890 regulations will be reviewed (with possible rulemaking action by the BRN) at this week's Nov. 16 meeting of the NPAC, followed by the Nov. 17-18 meeting of the full BRN Board. [CANP submitted a formal comment letter](#) prepared by Legislative Advocate Kristy Wiese and our coalition partners, which provides critical feedback to the BRN on the draft regulations.

We commend members of the BRN and the NPAC for their leadership and thank them for their work as we strive to expand access to care for patients in need. ## *Chapter Quarterly Reports*

September 30 marked the end of the first quarter for CANP's 2021-2022 fiscal year. The Quarter 1 reports were distributed in November via email to all Chapter Presidents.

Reminder, all chapters must submit a quarterly report and meet the elements outlined in Addendum D of the [CANP and CANP Chapter Alignment Agreement](#) to receive a dues check. Per Addendum D of the Alignment Agreement, if the compliance measures are not met in any quarter, that quarter's chapter dues disbursement check will not be issued to the chapter. Also, per terms of the Alignment Agreement, checks will not be distributed retroactively.
