Student Research Data Access

One of the benefits of being a CANP member is having access to purchase the Student Research Data Access for NP students. Prior to graduation, NP students must fulfill critical research requirements, including collecting survey data among practicing NPs. From systematic changes to treatment interventions, our NP students are at the forefront of new, innovative research informing the future of the profession.

CANP student members seeking to send surveys required for educational credits to CANP's membership can purchase the Student Research Data Access in the CANP Store. Each submission costs \$100 per survey. Every quarter, approved surveys will be distributed to CANP's membership. New Grad Workshop

CANP recently launched the New Graduate Workshop lecture series, supported by NSO, led by CANP nurse practitioner experts who cover common topics for new graduates preparing to enter the NP workforce. The workshop provides important training to support the transition from school to actual workplace settings.

Chapter Quarterly Reports

March 31 marked the end of the third quarter for CANP's 2021-2022 fiscal year. The quarter 3 reports were distributed in April via email to all Chapter Presidents.

Reminder, all chapters must submit a quarterly report and meet the elements outlined in Addendum D of the [CANP and CANP Chapter Alignment Agreement](#) to receive a dues check. Per Addendum D of

the Alignment Agreement, if the compliance measures are not met in any quarter, that quarter's chapter dues disbursement check will not be issued to the chapter. Also, per terms of the Alignment Agreement, checks will not be distributed retroactively.

Below is a list of reporting due dates for the 2021-2022 fiscal year:

| Quarter | Dates | Report Due Date |
|-----------|-------------------------------------|------------------|
| Quarter 1 | July 1, 2021 – September 30, 2021 | October 16, 2021 |
| Quarter 2 | October 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021 | January 29, 2022 |
| Quarter 3 | January 1, 2022 – March 31, 2022 | April 30, 2022 |
| Quarter 4 | April 1, 2022 – June 30, 2022 | July 23, 2022 |
