Depending on the availability this scholarship will be awarded once a year to one or more active CANP-Channel Islands Nurse Practitioner student. The candidate for this scholarship must be already enrolled into an accredited graduate nursing program for Master of Science in Nursing, Doctor of Nursing (DNP), PhD and/or any program related to the advancement of a nursing degree. The amount of the award is based on the amount monies collected during the year supporting the CANP – Channels Islands Nurse Practitioner Advancement Program therefore this award may vary year to year.

Nurse Practitioner Advancement Award (NPAA)

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**PREFERENCE** will be given to qualified applicants who are enrolled in an accredited graduate nursing programs for Master of Science in Nursing (MSN), Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP), Doctor of Philosophy in nursing (**PhD**), Certified Nurse Midwives, Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists or Clinical Nurse Specialists as a part-time or full-time student.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

#### **Part One**

1. Completed CANP-Channel Islands Chapter NPAA form
2. Proof of enrollment full-time or part-time as a student in an accredited graduate nursing degree program
3. Must have been a member of CANP-Channel Islands Chapter for at least three months and attended one chapter meeting
4. Must have attended a CANP – Channel Islands Chapter meeting prior to the application date
5. Proof of participation in any form of CANP grassroots efforts such as but not limited to the following: Use of Social Media, Face to Face meeting with an Elected Official and/or sent letters seeking support.
6. Provide evidence of participation in expanding who nurse practitioners are and how we impact the community.
